Since you are receiving a copy of our Annual Report, you have chosen to make Goshen Valley a trusted investment. There is not a day that goes by that we do not acknowledge and give thanks for all that the collective “you” do on behalf of our growing mission.

We are indeed growing. Today, Goshen serves more children than ever before in our 20+ years of ministry. With an average of 120 children and youth entrusted in our care each day, we are doing all we can to serve the unique needs that we face, such as serving teenage boys within a family setting, reuniting sibling groups, and preparing young adults to age out of foster care.

We realize more than ever before that Goshen has an obligation to serve families in an attempt to prevent the need for foster care. In 2023, those efforts will come full circle with the opening of the Goshen Family Resource Center. Located in Canton, Georgia, the 6,500 sq ft Goshen Family Resource Center will serve as a hub for mental and behavioral health services.

Along with a clinical staff, the GFRC will house community advocates who will be trained to assess and connect families with local resources geared towards supporting their most immediate needs. I'll plan to share more about the project's impact as we draw closer to its opening.

We look forward to Goshen's next steps! Believing our most important days are ahead, the support that has gotten us this far will be needed going forward. 🙏

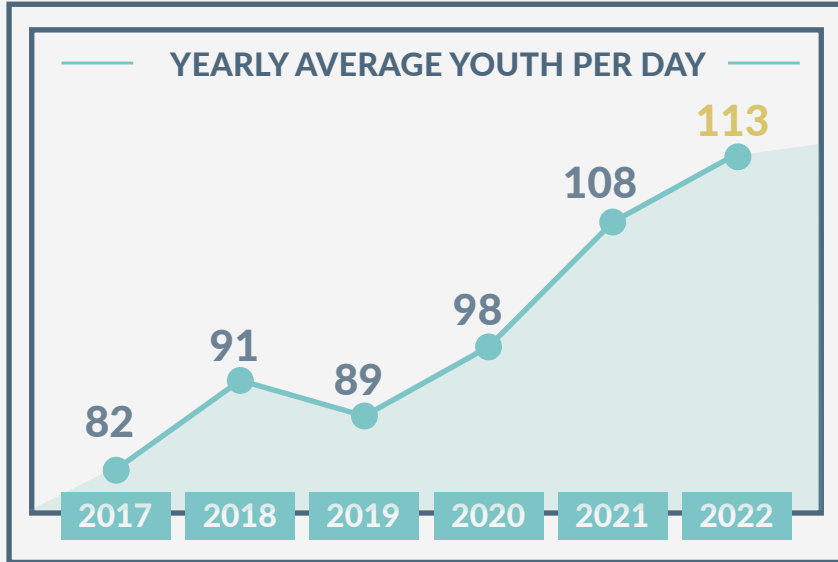

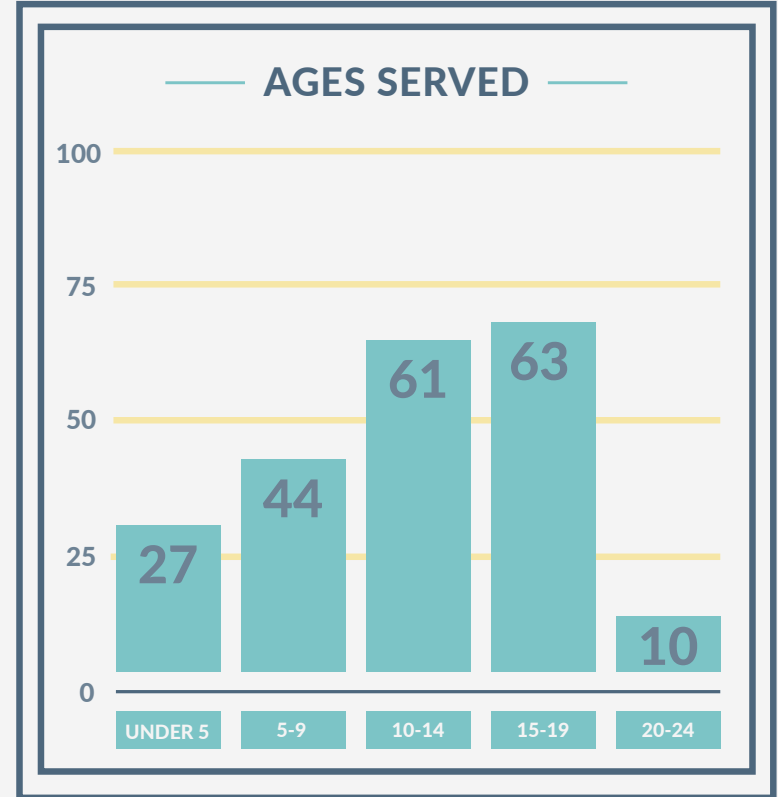

Too many young men in foster care end up in places that feel more like a prison than a family.

Goshen Valley Boys Ranch exists to provide young men in foster care with the safety of a home, the love of a family, and the hope of a future. The Ranch is the top-rated group home for foster youth in North Georgia.

OBJECTIVES

FAMILY MODEL

1

Our houseparents are the heroes of the Ranch. While most group homes have shift workers, our houseparents live in the homes with our boys, creating an environment that feels as much like family as possible.

EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT

2

Most foster youth struggle educationally. With intensive educational support, a young man at Goshen will on average see a 10 point GPA increase within 6 months. Our graduation rate among eligible youth remains at 100%.

THERAPEUTIC SERVICES

3

In 2022 over 1,700 individual counseling sessions took place at The Ranch. We believe in the power of counseling, and we have seen lives healed and futures changed because of it.

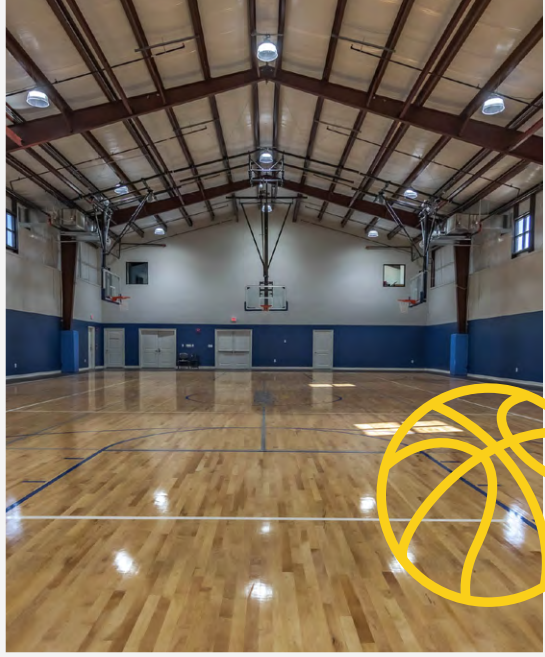

Goshen New Beginnings exists to lead older foster youth into thriving independence. Our aim is to provide training and support in education, employment, and life skills that youth need in the transition into adulthood.

FOCUS AREAS

1 EMPLOYMENT

Finding and maintaining quality employment is critical to their long term success. We work with several local companies who do an excellent job mentoring our youth while putting them in positions to succeed in a career.

2 EDUCATION

Education gives our youth a foundation for a life of independence. We guide our youth through college, technical school, and GED programs, or professional certifications.

3 LIFE SKILLS

Personal finance, drivers education, and resume workshops are all critical parts of thriving independence. Our youth experience these and more at weekly life skills trainings.

Goshen Homes exists to recruit, train, license, and support foster families working with sibling groups. Our aim is to provide loving family environments to youth in foster care while keeping siblings together.

3 WAYS TO SERVE FOSTER YOUTH

1 PRIMARY FOSTER PARENT

Our primary foster parents become full-time caretakers to the foster youth placed in their care. As a licensed sibling reunification agency, Goshen Homes focuses on foster homes able to take in 2 or more youth.

2 RESPITE FOSTER PARENT

Respite parents become the aunt or uncle figures to a foster child. This is a great way to have an impact on a foster child without the full-time commitment of having them live in your home.

3 BABYSITTING

You may not be completely ready to foster right now, but you still want to make a difference. By babysitting with Goshen Homes, you can help to support foster parents while still showing love and care to the siblings at Goshen Homes.

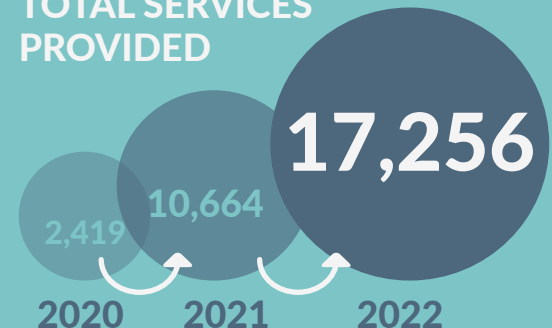
Goshen Therapeutic Services provides mental health and family support services to prevent families from experiencing a crisis, lowering rates of foster care, addiction, and self-harm in our community.

“I provide counseling to a single mother and her elementary-aged daughter every week. Her daughter was adopted as a toddler from an abusive home, and she has autism along with several other diagnoses. Her daughter does not like when our sessions come to an end, so we have been able to use visits to our food pantry as an exciting way to transition from counseling sessions to going home. The girl is always so excited that we have her favorite foods, like those little boxes of cereal and applesauce. The mom has also been grateful to have access to dinner items and hygiene products. We are so happy to be able to meet the complex needs of this family through counseling and through tangible household items.” 🏠

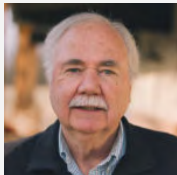
CHASE CHITWOOD,

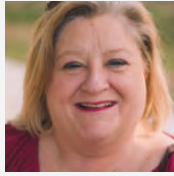
BRIAN SPIVEY,
